10) Questions from the Public-

- Cynthia Piper-When could the Valemount Glacier Destination be built as it is one the community forest area? Craig Pryor- Not sure after approval of their VGD master plan. There is a complex bridge to be built that may take three to four weeks however this won't affect logging operations.
- Cynthia Piper-For the BC timber sale (BCTS) does VCF have a buyer yet? Craig Pryor- BCTS is going to upgrade the road first. We don't have a buyer for the wood yet. Discussion- the VCF has been in communicae with BCTS and plans to bid on future BCTS sales.
- 3) Why did the volume go from 100,000m3 to 70,000m3? Craig Pryor explains about the Mountain Pine Beetle epidemic and need to have an up-lift in the AAC in order to harvest the MPB and the fall-down effect after harvest. That is why the AAC is back to an AAC of 33,000m3 cut in the original K2T. So now the community forest is moving forward in a regular way.
- 4) Rashmi Narayan- What is a good volume?



Craig Pryor- 100,000m3 is a nice volume.

Gordon Carson- Part of the solution is making the volume we have work more. Such as house logs and other fibre getting 'the right log to the right place' Cedar poles- figuring out the best way to proceed and balancing wood leaving the valley versus staying here.
