

General Update

March 2, 2017

Harvesting:

Mickelson is harvesting on CM01 on Canoe Mountain. All SPF wood to be delivered to Carrier with the Cedar sold to CVH, Ski Lumber and Gilbert Smith.

Jerry Plummer is harvesting on SC04 up Swift Creek targeting large diameter fir and pine.

Mike Widell is harvesting pine post wood up Canoe Mountain.

Roads:

A short spur road was built into CM01 to allow for harvest.

Mill Site:

Canfor has decked wood in its 5-acre lease and should start reprocessing soon with hauling during break-up.

Sort Yard:

VCF has hauled shake, post and rail cedar and oversize spruce into the yard from CM01. We will scale and sort the cedar which will be sold to CVH. The oversize spruce will be bucked to Kermode spec, oversize spec and to Carrier Spec.

Still some fir and spruce in the yard to haul from the West canoe. All volume sold.

Hugh Hamilton out of 100-mile House has taken a load of house logs and wants more. Mark Degal has one more load of house logs peeled and held for him. There are 3-4 loads of house logs in yard. VCF plans to sell remaining logs by spring.

Planning/Other:

Greenstar laying out SPF wood up the Westridge. VCF staff are working on recci areas up Kiwa with good results thus far.

Working with the MOF on fine tuning the TSR submission before we run the model which will help determine the new AAC.

Silviculture:

VCF staff working on RESULTS reporting submissions and making good progress.
