

General Update

June 1, 2018

Harvesting:

Mickelson working up the West Canoe processing and loading hemlock with the sawlogs sold to Interfor and the pulp sold to Canfor PG. Mickelson is also harvesting deciduous along the West Canoe FSR. This wood sold to Norboard 100 Mile House.

Plummer signed in to harvest pine along Highway 5 across from Cedarside road. This wood was left as a buffer but is blowing down badly and needs to be cleaned up. Plummer will go up above 5km on the East Canoe to harvest douglas fir for Larry Simpson when completed on block SC12.

Roads:

Jackman working on upgrading road into SC12 then off to BCTS work.

Grader working on West Canoe and Westridge.

Mill Site:

Caputo and Sons have removed transformers from CVH yard and has stored them behind Kilns. Also removed poles through out yard that were not in use. This work was done at the request of BC Hydro.

CVH post and rail has started and working out bugs.

Sort Yard:

Sort yard has been cleared out. Small amount remaining that could not make full loads.

Planning/Other:

Greenstar is working on SP data and creeks from the winter layout.

Following the fire preparedness plan meeting we are starting to talk with local landowners to make a plan for a Forest Licence cutting permit outside VCF areas to clean up high priority fire hazard areas. Carrier has accepted offer to deliver this wood to them without tendering and replace volume on forest licence.

VCF has purchased a Honda quad out of Edson for about \$9000 including taxes.

Grants:

Nothing ongoing.

Silviculture:

Tree planting has started and is progressing through blocks. All good thus far.

Dan Cuddeback and Greenstar brushing deciduous on cutblocks. Covering lots of ground targeting only deciduous.
