9. New Business:

- a) Summer log market-prices are low or the companies are not buying. Stumpage rates will become lower in July. Some companies are struggling for shortage of supply. Covid 19 has affected markets and the economy this has been felt across the forest industry.
- b) Summer Road work- rethinking the original plan due to markets and considering other options such as Cedar; we must log Fdi with Beetle infestations. Setting up plans to use the Forest Licence to optimize logging opportunities.
- c) Fir and Spruce beetle-Ptarmigan has been hit hard in the BCTS blocks, these blocks are over 18 months old and the value of those blocks has plummeted. Yellowjacket (VCF K2T) is north and adjacent to that valley and focus will be on monitoring the Spruce beetle in the VCF area. Fir Bark Beetle is continuing to be monitored and beetle traps visited. Learning a lot on management of these beetles.
 - Comment on the positive historical value of the fines from overweight trucks \$\$ going to local non-profit groups.
- d) Directory initiative-ads were placed in the VCF WEBSITE, newspaper, VCTV, around town and there is word of mouth. The response has been slow, but there are some resumes coming in. Discussion-it is the responsibility of individuals/contractors to read and keep up to date with what is going on. Would Face book be an option?
