### Mill Construction Update:

## **General Update:**

- We have taken our first orders for 8x8 timbers 14 and 16 feet long. We are currently working on these orders.
- <u>Phase 1</u> is complete. Includes: log infeed, debarker, headrig, main waste conveyor, cut off saw, vibrating conveyor, metal detector, chipper, shaker screen and chip bins.
- Phase 2 is ongoing. Includes edger, infeed and outfeed. 95% complete
- Dust system: An engineer specializing in mill dust systems toured mill. Would like to see mill
  in operation before making plan. Crew working on minimizing dust issues before we look at a
  dust system.
- We have installed a small dust system for the debarker which has helped but not solve the problem.
