Harvesting:

AAA Logging Ltd. has finished harvesting blocks W32, W34 and W47 up the Westridge. All wood hauled and done for winter season.

Spaz has finished harvesting on block CV06 and has shut down operations on block CV01 located at 11km. This will be their start-up spot.

Jerry Plummer has finished harvesting on block W31 up the West ridge. All wood hauled and done for winter season.

Dan Cuddeback has finished a small area in block W43. This area had active douglas fir beetle the past couple years and we wanted to remove the infested trees before the next flight. All wood hauled and done for winter season.

Planning/Other:

Snowshoeing conditions are great. We have a long list of blocks to recci. Found so far: 90ha of spruce balsam beyond 22km Westridge 90ha of partial cut up Derek Road Layed out 55ha up Packsaddle (Block PS04) 14ha of Sx/Bl pulp/sawlog mix at 7km Westridge 20ha block south of Bike Park 55ha of SxBl up Family Loop Road

Woodlot: Harvesting planned for this summer if possible.

Forest Licence:

CP 3 has been submitted and am now waiting on Simpcw FN Cultural Heritage assessments. CP 4 has been submitted. Bocks up the Croyden and West Canoe.

Sort Yard:

Working on a deal to sell oversize spruce to Dunkley, Fuso and Music Spruce. Roughly 70 loads of oversize spruce and 70 loads of Carrier SPF and fir are in the yard. Hope to start shipping Dunkley wood April 3 and Carrier wood April 24.

Silviculture:
